+ CANTICLE OF ZECHARIAH

We bless you, Adonai, <u>God</u> of *Israel*, for you come to visit us and ransom <u>us</u> from *bondage*. You have brought forth a <u>strong</u> De-*liverer* in the house of <u>your</u> child *David*.

+ COMMEMORATION: Jesse Lee

Jesse Lee was brought to conversion in 1773 and soon appointed a Methodist class leader. Lee gave the first of hundreds of sermons in 1779 in the North Carolina area and then developed a deep sense of being called to extend Methodism in New England. In 1789, Bishop Asbury appointed Lee to circuits first in Connecticut, then Massachusetts, and then Maine.
