+ COMMEMORATION: SARAH CROSBY

"In a time when women's public speaking was considered shameful and unnatural, Sarah Crosby discovered an inner peace and conviction of her call. John Wesley came to the defense of what he called the "extraordinary call" of her ministry as it grew from class meeting to open-air preaching. As women's religious leadership opportunities expanded, their influence on social patterns widened. Schools were founded, prison reform begun, and medical help for the poor extended as women such as Sarah Crosby found their voice in the outpouring of the spirit. Within a decade after John Wesley's death, the recognition of the extraordinary ministry of women turned into repression. Women were barred from the ministry of preaching."
