- ⁵² They started arguing with each other and asked, "How can he give us his flesh to eat?"

I tell you for certain that you won't live unless you eat the flesh and drink the blood of the Son of Man. ⁵⁴ But if you do eat my flesh and drink my blood, you will have eternal life, and I will raise you to life on the last day. ⁵⁵ My flesh is the true food, and my blood is the true drink. ⁵⁶ If you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you are one with me, and I am one with you.

+ CANTICLE OF ZECHARIAH

Joseph is revered as the faithful husband of Mary and caring stepfather of Jesus. In the Gospels he appears mostly in the birth narratives in Matthew and Luke. Matthew traces the lineage of Joseph back to David. He probably owned

property in Bethlehem, so he and Mary went there for the census.

Joseph is often depicted holding a lily and a staff. When remembering him, we can think of his caring and loving parenting, his integrity as a husband, and his courage to follow visions.
