+ WORD: John 16:1-15 CEV

I am telling you this to keep you from being afraid. ² You will be chased out of the Jewish meeting places. And the time will come when people will kill you and think they are doing God a favor. ³ They will do these things because they don't know either the Father or me. ⁴ I am saying this to you now, so that when the time comes, you will remember what I have said.

I was with you at the first, and so I didn't tell you these things. ⁵ But now I am going back to the Father who sent me, and none of you asks me where I am going. ⁶ You are very sad from hearing all of this. ⁷ But I tell you that I am going to do what is best for you. That is why I am going away. The Holy Spirit cannot come to help you until I leave. But after I am gone, I will send the Spirit to you.

+ CANTICLE OF ZECHARIAH

We bless you, Adonai, <u>God</u> of *Israel*, for you come to visit us and ransom <u>us</u> from *bondage*. You have brought forth a <u>strong</u> De-*liverer* in the house of <u>your</u> child *David*.

This is what your holy <u>prophets</u> an-*nounced*: deliverance from enemies and from the hand of <u>all</u> who hate *us*; mercy a-<u>mong</u> our *ancestors*, and remembrance of your <u>ho</u>-ly *covenant*.

+ THE APOSTLE'S CREED

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth. + COMMEMORATION: WILLIAM LAW

Born in 1686 in Northamptonshire, Law was elected a fellow of Emmanuel College, Cambridge in 1711, ordained shortly after, and appeared to have a bright future in the Church. This changed, however, when he refused to take an oath of allegiance to King George I in 1714. Becoming a Non-Juror cost him the position at Cambridge and stalled his ecclesiastical career.

Denied ecclesiastical advancement, Law turned to devotional writing. A Practical Treatise upon Christian Perfection (1726) addressed the common misconception that perfection required a monastic lifestyle. Stressing the inner disposition of the Christian, he held that the pursuit of perfection required the formation of religious societies for fellowship, exhortation, and spiritual examination.
