# \* WORD: Daniel 5:13-30 CEV

<sup>13</sup> When Daniel was brought in, the king said:

So you are Daniel, one of the captives my father brought back from Judah! <sup>14</sup> I was told that the gods have given you special powers and that you are intelligent and very wise. <sup>15</sup> Neither my advisors nor the men who talk with the spirits of the dead could read this writing or tell me what it means. <sup>16</sup> But I have been told that you understand everything and that you can solve difficult problems. Now then, if you can read this writing and tell me what it means, you will become the third most powerful man in my kingdom. You will wear royal purple robes and have a gold chain around your neck.

### <sup>17</sup> Daniel answered:

Your Majesty, I will read the writing and tell you what it means. But you may keep your gifts or give them to someone else. <sup>18</sup> Sir, the Most High God made your father

a great and powerful man and brought him much honor and glory. <sup>19</sup> God did such great things for him that people of all nations and races shook with fear.

Your father had the power of life or death over everyone, and he could honor or ruin anyone he chose. <sup>20</sup> But when he became proud and stubborn, his glorious kingdom was taken from him. <sup>21</sup> His mind became like that of an animal, and he was forced to stay away from people and live with wild donkeys. Your father ate grass like an ox, and he slept outside where his body was soaked with dew. He was forced to do this until he learned that the Most High God rules all kingdoms on earth and chooses their kings.

<sup>22</sup> King Belshazzar, you knew all of this, but you still refused to honor the Lord who rules from heaven.

<sup>23</sup> Instead, you turned against him and ordered the cups from his temple to be brought here, so that you and your wives and officials could drink wine from them. You praised idols made of silver, gold, bronze, iron, wood, and stone, even though they cannot see or hear or think. You refused to worship the God who gives you breath and controls everything you do. <sup>24</sup> That's why he sent the hand to write this message on the wall.

<sup>25-28</sup> The words written there are mene, which means "numbered," tekel, which means "weighed," and parsin, which means "divided." God has numbered the days of your kingdom and has brought it to an end. He has weighed you on his balance scales, and you fall short of what it takes to be king. So God has divided your kingdom between the Medes and the Persians.

<sup>29</sup> Belshazzar gave a command for Daniel to be made the third most powerful man in his kingdom and to be given a purple robe and a gold chain.

<sup>30</sup> That same night, the king was killed.

- <sup>5</sup> Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act.
- <sup>6</sup> He will make your vindication shine like the light, and the justice of your cause like the noonday.
- <sup>7</sup> Be still before the LORD, and wait patiently for him; do not fret over those who prosper in their way, over those who carry out evil devices.
- 8 Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath.
  Do not fret—it leads only to evil.
- <sup>9</sup> For the wicked shall be cut off, but those who wait for the LORD shall inherit the land.
- <sup>10</sup> Yet a little while, and the wicked will be no more; though you look diligently for their place, they will not be there.
- <sup>11</sup> But the meek shall inherit the land, and delight themselves in abundant prosperity.

- <sup>12</sup> The wicked plot against the righteous, and gnash their teeth at them;
- <sup>13</sup> but the LORD laughs at the wicked, for he sees that their day is coming.
- <sup>14</sup> The wicked draw the sword and bend their bows to bring down the poor and needy, to kill those who walk uprightly;
- <sup>15</sup> their sword shall enter their own heart, and their bows shall be broken.
- <sup>16</sup> Better is a little that the righteous person has than the abundance of many wicked.
- <sup>17</sup> For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, but the LORD upholds the righteous.
- <sup>18</sup> The LORD knows the days of the blameless, and their heritage will abide forever;

## \* WORD: Luke 5:1-11 CEV

Jesus was standing on the shore of Lake Gennesaret, teaching the people as they crowded around him to hear God's message. <sup>2</sup> Near the shore he saw two boats left there by some fishermen who had gone to wash their nets. <sup>3</sup> Jesus got into the boat that belonged to Simon and asked him to row it out a little way from the shore. Then Jesus sat down in the boat to teach the crowd.

<sup>4</sup> When Jesus had finished speaking, he told Simon, "Row the boat out into the deep water and let your nets down to catch some fish."

<sup>5</sup> "Master," Simon answered, "we have worked hard all night long and have not caught a thing. But if you tell me to, I will let the nets down." <sup>6</sup> They did it and caught so many fish that their nets began ripping apart. <sup>7</sup> Then they signaled for their partners in the other boat to come and help them. The men came, and together they filled the two boats so full that they both began to sink.

<sup>8</sup> When Simon Peter saw this happen, he knelt down in front of Jesus and said, "Lord, don't come near me! I am a sinner." <sup>9</sup> Peter and everyone with him were completely surprised at all the fish they had caught. <sup>10</sup> His partners

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were surprised too.

Jesus told Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on you will bring in people instead of fish." <sup>11</sup> The men pulled their boats up on the shore. Then they left everything and went with Jesus.
