* **1st READING: Philippians 4:10-20** CEB

¹⁰ I was very glad in the Lord because now at last you
have shown concern for me again. (Of course you were
always concerned but had no way to show it.) ¹¹ I'm not
saying this because I need anything, for I have learned
how to be content in any circumstance. ¹² I know the
experience of being in need and of having more than

enough; I have learned the secret to being content in any and every circumstance, whether full or hungry or whether having plenty or being poor. ¹³ I can endure all these things through the power of the one who gives me strength. ¹⁴ Still, you have done well to share my distress.

¹⁵ You Philippians know from the time of my first mission work in Macedonia how no church shared in supporting my ministry except you. ¹⁶ You sent contributions repeatedly to take care of my needs even while I was in Thessalonica. ¹⁷ I'm not hoping for a gift, but I am hoping for a profit that accumulates in your account. ¹⁸ I now have plenty and it is more than enough. I am full to overflowing because I received the gifts that you sent from Epaphroditus. Those gifts give off a fragrant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice that pleases God. ¹⁹ My God will meet your every need out of his riches in the glory that is found in Christ Jesus. ²⁰ Let glory be given to God our Father forever and always. Amen.

* **GOSPEL: John 17:20-26** CEB

²⁰ "I'm not praying only for them but also for those who believe in me because of their word. ²¹ I pray they will be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. I pray that they also will be in us, so that the world will believe that you sent me. ²² I've given them the glory that you gave me so that they can be one just as we are one. ²³ I'm in them and you are in me so that they will be made perfectly one. Then the world will know that you sent me and that you have loved them just as you loved me.

²⁴ "Father, I want those you gave me to be with me where I am. Then they can see my glory, which you gave me because you loved me before the creation of the world.
