### \* 151 READING: 1 Peter 2:1-10 CEB

Therefore, get rid of all ill will and all deceit, pretense, envy, and slander. <sup>2</sup> Instead, like a newborn baby, desire the pure milk of the word. Nourished by it, you will grow

into salvation, <sup>3</sup> since you have tasted that the Lord is good.

<sup>4</sup> Now you are coming to him as to a living stone. Even though this stone was rejected by humans, from God's perspective it is chosen, valuable. <sup>5</sup> You yourselves are being built like living stones into a spiritual temple. You are being made into a holy priesthood to offer up spiritual sacrifices that are acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. <sup>6</sup> Thus it is written in scripture, *Look! I am laying a* cornerstone in Zion, chosen, valuable. The person who believes in him will never be shamed. <sup>7</sup> So God honors you who believe. For those who refuse to believe, though, the stone the builders tossed aside has become the capstone. 8 This is a stone that makes people stumble and a rock that makes them fall. Because they refuse to believe in the word, they stumble. Indeed, this is the end to which they were appointed. <sup>9</sup> But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people who are God's own possession. You have become this people so that you may speak of the wonderful acts of the one who called you out of darkness into his amazing light. <sup>10</sup> Once you weren't a people, but now you are God's people. Once you hadn't received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

### \* **COSPEL John 15:1-11** CEB

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vineyard keeper.

<sup>2</sup> He removes any of my branches that don't produce fruit, and he trims any branch that produces fruit so that it will produce even more fruit. <sup>3</sup> You are already trimmed because of the word I have spoken to you. <sup>4</sup> Remain in me, and I will remain in you. A branch can't produce fruit by itself, but must remain in the vine. Likewise, you can't produce fruit unless you remain in me. <sup>5</sup> I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, then you will produce much fruit. Without me, you can't do anything. <sup>6</sup> If you don't remain in me, you will be like a branch that is thrown out and dries up. Those branches are gathered up, thrown into a fire, and burned. <sup>7</sup> If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. <sup>8</sup> My Father

is glorified when you produce much fruit and in this way prove that you are my disciples.

<sup>9</sup> "As the Father loved me, I too have loved you. Remain in my love. <sup>10</sup> If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. <sup>11</sup> I have said these things to you so that my joy will be in you and your joy will be complete.
