* MORNING CANTICLE OF PRAISE

Come, let us sing to the <u>Ho</u>ly *One*; let us shout for joy to the Rock of <u>our</u> sal*vation*. *Let us come before God's presence* <u>with</u> thanksgiving, and raise a loud <u>shout</u> with psalms. For you, O God, <u>are a</u> great *God*, you are great a<u>bove</u> all gods. *In your hand are the <u>caverns</u> of the earth, and the heights of the hills <u>are</u> yours also.*

The sea is yours, <u>for</u> you made it, and your hands have molded <u>the</u> dry land. **Come, let us bow down and <u>bend</u> the knee, and kneel before <u>God</u>, our Maker.**

*** SILENCE FOR REFLECTION**

* 1st READING: Romans 7:1-12 CEB

Brothers and sisters, I'm talking to you as people who know the Law. Don't you know that the Law has power over someone only as long as he or she lives? ² A married woman is united with her husband under the Law while he is alive. But if her husband dies, she is released from the Law concerning her husband. ³ So then, if she lives with another man while her husband is alive, she's committing adultery. But if her husband dies, she's free from the Law, so she won't be committing adultery if she marries someone else. ⁴ Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you also died with respect to the Law through the body of Christ, so that you could be united with someone else. You are united with the one who was raised from the dead so that we can bear fruit for God. ⁵ When we were selfcentered, the sinful passions aroused through the Law were at work in all the parts of our body, so that we bore fruit for death. ⁶ But now we have been released from the Law. We have died with respect to the thing that controlled us, so that we can be slaves in the new life under the Spirit, not in the old life under the written Law.

⁷ So what are we going to say? That the Law is sin? Absolutely not! But I wouldn't have known sin except through the Law. I wouldn't have known the desire for what others have if the Law had not said, *Don't desire to*

take what others have. ⁸ But sin seized the opportunity and used this commandment to produce all kinds of desires in me. Sin is dead without the Law. ⁹ I used to be alive without the Law, but when the commandment came, sin sprang to life, ¹⁰ and I died. So the commandment that was intended to give life brought death. ¹¹ Sin seized the opportunity through the commandment, deceived me, and killed me. ¹² So the Law itself is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous, and good.

*** SILENCE FOR REFLECTION**

* 2nd READING: Matthew 21:23-32 CEB

²³ When Jesus entered the temple, the chief priests and elders of the people came to him as he was teaching.They asked, "What kind of authority do you have for doing these things? Who gave you this authority?"

²⁴ Jesus replied, "I have a question for you. If you tell me the answer, I'll tell you what kind of authority I have to do these things. ²⁵ Where did John get his authority to baptize? Did he get it from heaven or from humans?"

They argued among themselves, "If we say 'from heaven,' he'll say to us, 'Then why didn't you believe him?' ²⁶ But we can't say 'from humans' because we're afraid of the crowd, since everyone thinks John was a prophet." ²⁷ Then they replied, "We don't know."

Jesus also said to them, "Neither will I tell you what kind of authority I have to do these things.

²⁸ "What do you think? A man had two sons. Now he came to the first and said, 'Son, go and work in the vineyard today.'

²⁹ "'No, I don't want to,' he replied. But later he changed his mind and went.

³⁰ "The father said the same thing to the other son, who replied, 'Yes, sir.' But he didn't go.

³¹ "Which one of these two did his father's will?"

They said, "The first one."

Jesus said to them, "I assure you that tax collectors and prostitutes are entering God's kingdom ahead of you.

³² For John came to you on the righteous road, and you didn't believe him. But tax collectors and prostitutes believed him. Yet even after you saw this, you didn't change your hearts and lives and you didn't believe him.

* CANTICLE OF ZECHARIAH

We bless you, Adonai, <u>God</u> of *Israel*, for you come to visit us and ransom <u>us</u> from *bondage*. You have brought forth a <u>strong</u> De-*liverer* in the house of your child *David*.

This is what your holy prophets an-nounced:

deliverance from enemies

and from the hand of <u>all</u> who hate us;

mercy a-mong our ancestors,

and remembrance of your ho-ly covenant.

This is the promise you swore to our <u>an</u>-cestor, *Abraham*, to make us <u>un</u>-a-*fraid*,

to rescue us from our enemies,

to serve before you, holy and just, all the days <u>of</u> our *lives*. And this, my little child, shall be called prophet of <u>the</u> Most *High*, going before you, Adonai, to pre-<u>pare</u> your *paths*, making your people <u>know</u> de-*liverance* by the forgiveness <u>of</u> their *sins*. Through your merciful compassions, <u>God</u> our *God*, the dawn from on <u>high</u> shall *visit us*, to shine on those kept in dungeons and the <u>shadows</u> of *death* and to guide our feet onto the <u>path</u> of *peace*.
