* **1st READING: Romans 12:9-21** CEB

⁹ Love should be shown without pretending. Hate evil, and hold on to what is good. ¹⁰ Love each other like the members of your family. Be the best at showing honor to each other. ¹¹ Don't hesitate to be enthusiastic—be on fire in the Spirit as you serve the Lord! ¹² Be happy in your hope, stand your ground when you're in trouble, and devote yourselves to prayer. ¹³ Contribute to the needs of God's people, and welcome strangers into your home. ¹⁴ Bless people who harass you—bless and don't curse them. ¹⁵ Be happy with those who are happy, and cry with those who are crying. ¹⁶ Consider everyone as equal, and don't think that you're better than anyone else. Instead, associate with people who have no status. Don't think that you're so smart. ¹⁷ Don't pay back anyone for their evil actions with evil actions, but show respect for what everyone else believes is good. ¹⁸ If possible, to the best of your ability, live at peace with all people. ¹⁹ Don't try to get revenge for yourselves, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath. It is written, *Revenge belongs to me; I will pay it back, says the Lord.* ²⁰ Instead, *If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink. By doing this, you will pile burning*

coals of fire upon his head. ²¹ Don't be defeated by evil, but defeat evil with good.

* **GOSPEL: Matthew 26:26-35** CEB

²⁶ While they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take and eat. This is my body." ²⁷ He took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from this, all of you. ²⁸ This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many so that their sins may be forgiven. ²⁹ I tell you, I won't drink wine again until that day when I drink it in a new way with you in my Father's kingdom." ³⁰ Then, after singing songs of praise, they went to the Mount of Olives. ³¹ Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Tonight you will all fall away because of me. This is because it is written, *I will hit the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will go off in all*

directions. ³² But after I'm raised up, I'll go before you to Galilee."

³³ Peter replied, "If everyone else stumbles because of you, I'll never stumble."

³⁴ Jesus said to him, "I assure you that, before the rooster crows tonight, you will deny me three times."

³⁵ Peter said, "Even if I must die alongside you, I won't deny you." All the disciples said the same thing.
